- ▶ **Fellows must be able to competently perform all medical, diagnostic, and surgical procedures considered essential for the area of practice. Fellows** must have supervised training that will enable them to demonstrate competence in the following critical care skills:
- ▶ IV.A.2.a).(2).(a).(i) circulatory: performance of invasive and noninvasive monitoring techniques, and the use of vasoactive agents and management of hypotension and shock; application of trans-esophageal and transthoracic cardiac ultrasound

- ▶ No guidance on what that means or how to do it
- ▶ SCCM has extensive recommendations for training
