The William H Backus hospital in Norwich CT (part of the Hartford Hospital network) has an immediate opening for an Acute Care Surgeon. Backus hospital serves as the only ACS verified Trauma Center east of the Connecticut River and serves as the critical access hospital for this substantial population of 400,000 people.

We are growing an Acute Care Program at this level III trauma center and the eligible surgeon would actively participate in a "surgeon of the week" model to cover emergency surgery and trauma. Surgeon of the Week in-house responsibilities is M-F / 7a-4p. Call duties are shared by the Trauma surgeons and general surgeons and will be around 5 calls month. Night calls are 4p-7a. Average census is 15 in morning rounding.

We are in the process of establishing a formal Surgical ICU with eventual goal to achieving Level II status in the next few years.
