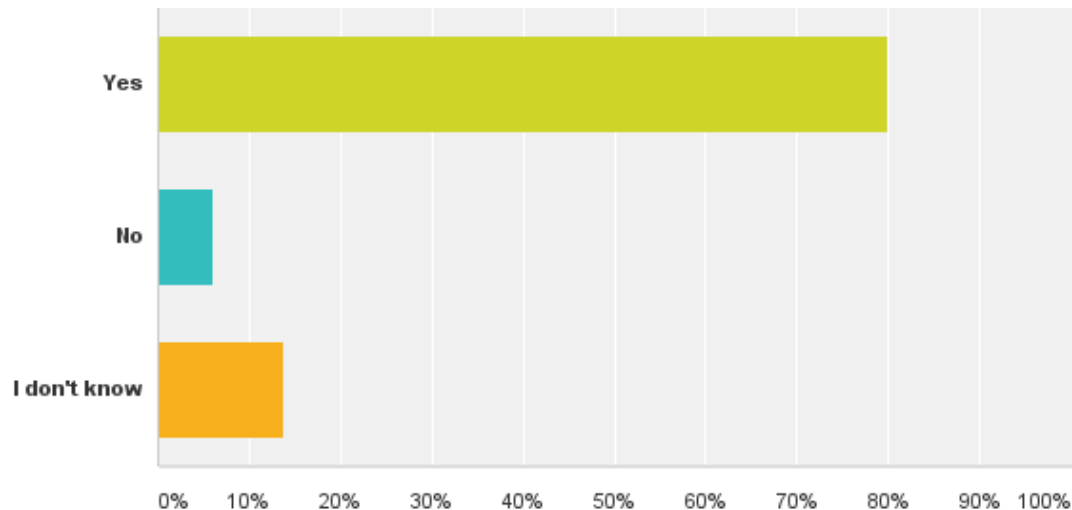

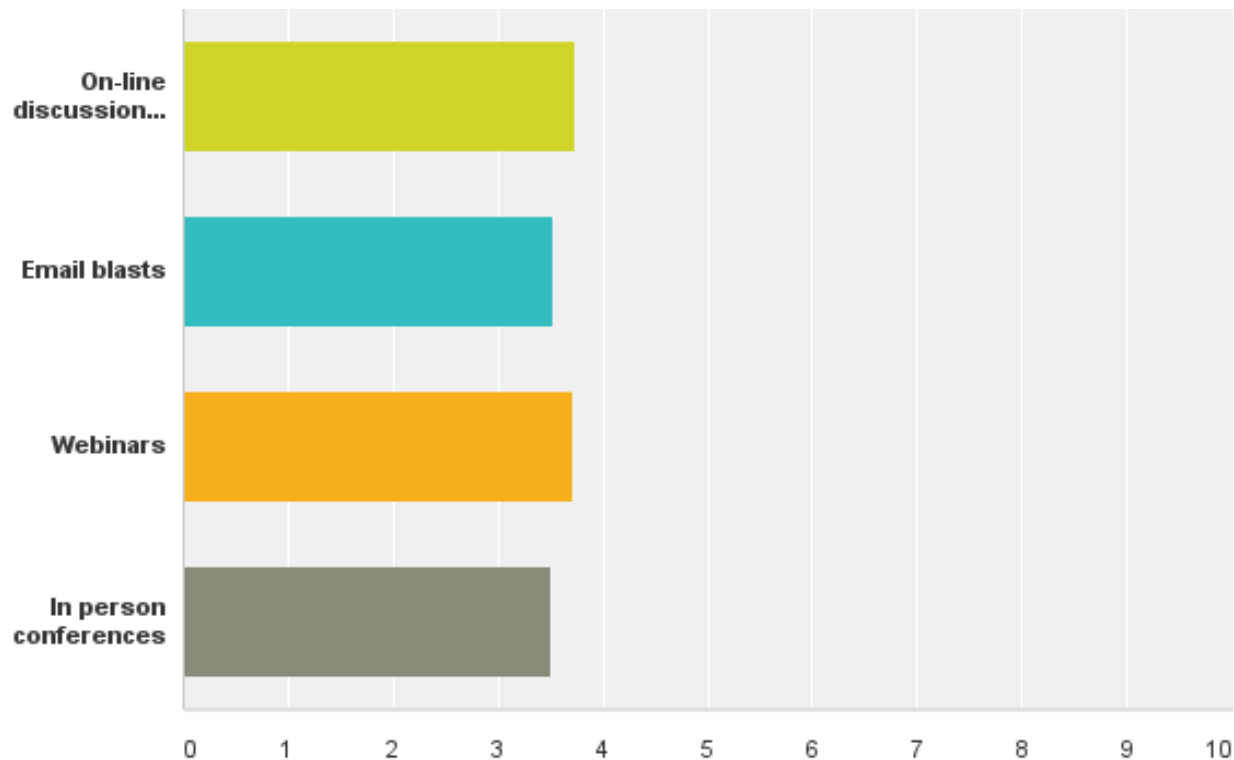
# Q1: Do you want to participate in a group forum for surgical critical care fellowship coordinators to communicate with each other?

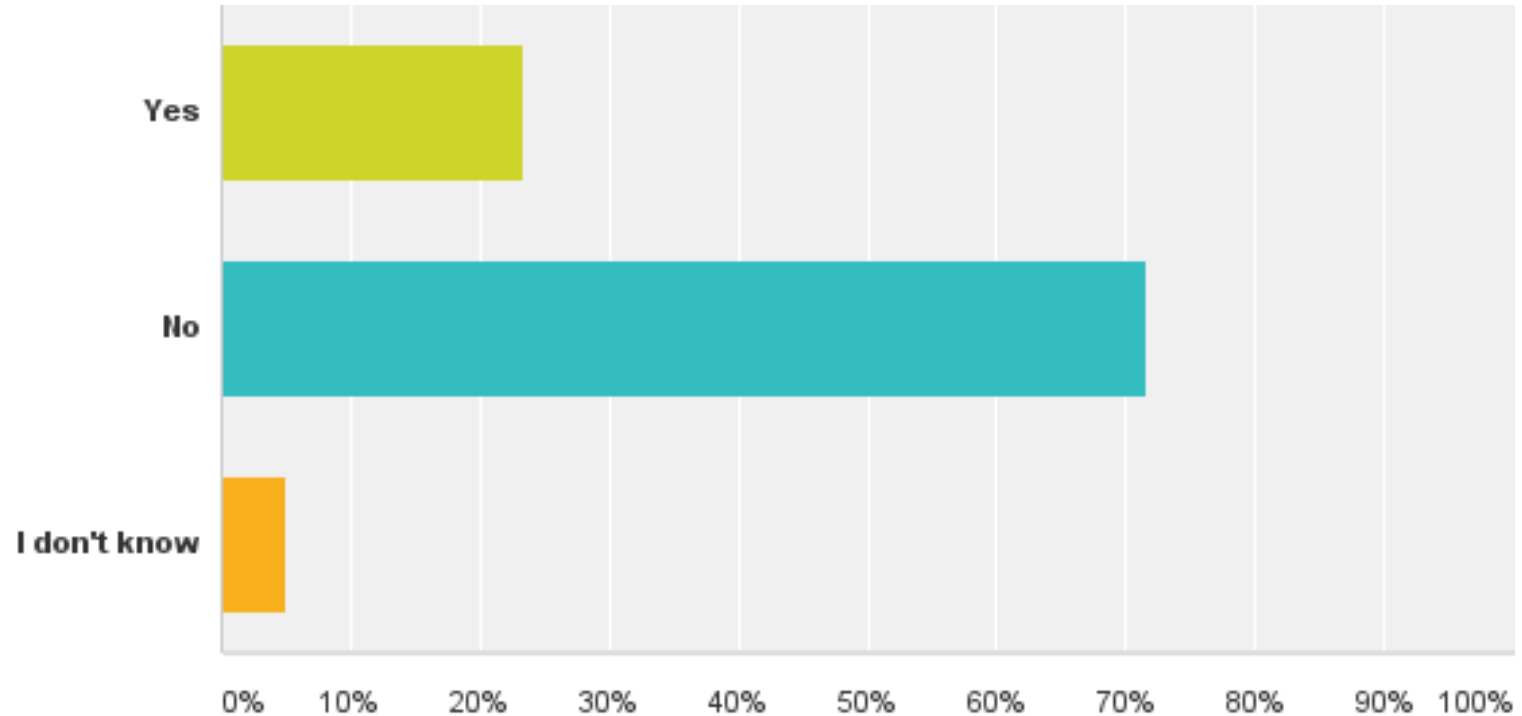
## Q2: If you are interested in a forum, please rate your interest in each of the following methods:

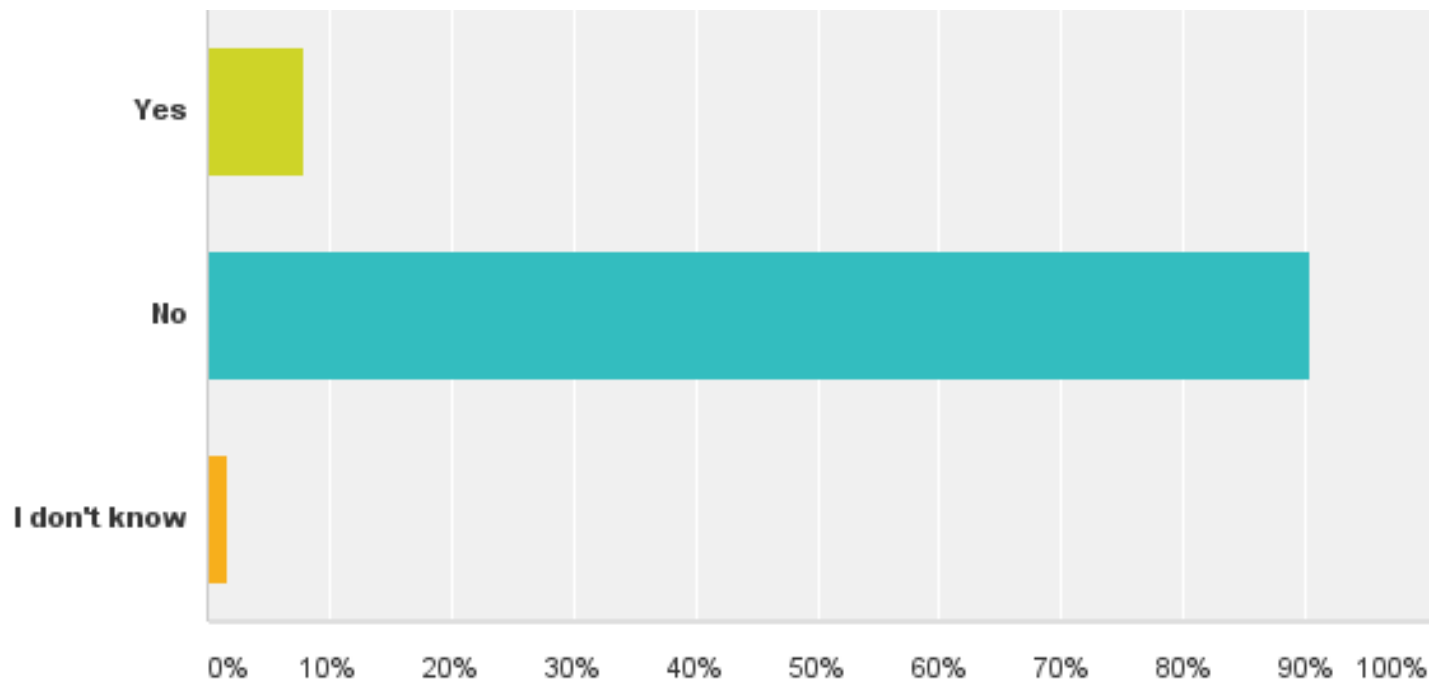
### Q3: Are you aware of the Groupspaces.com list serve for program coordinators

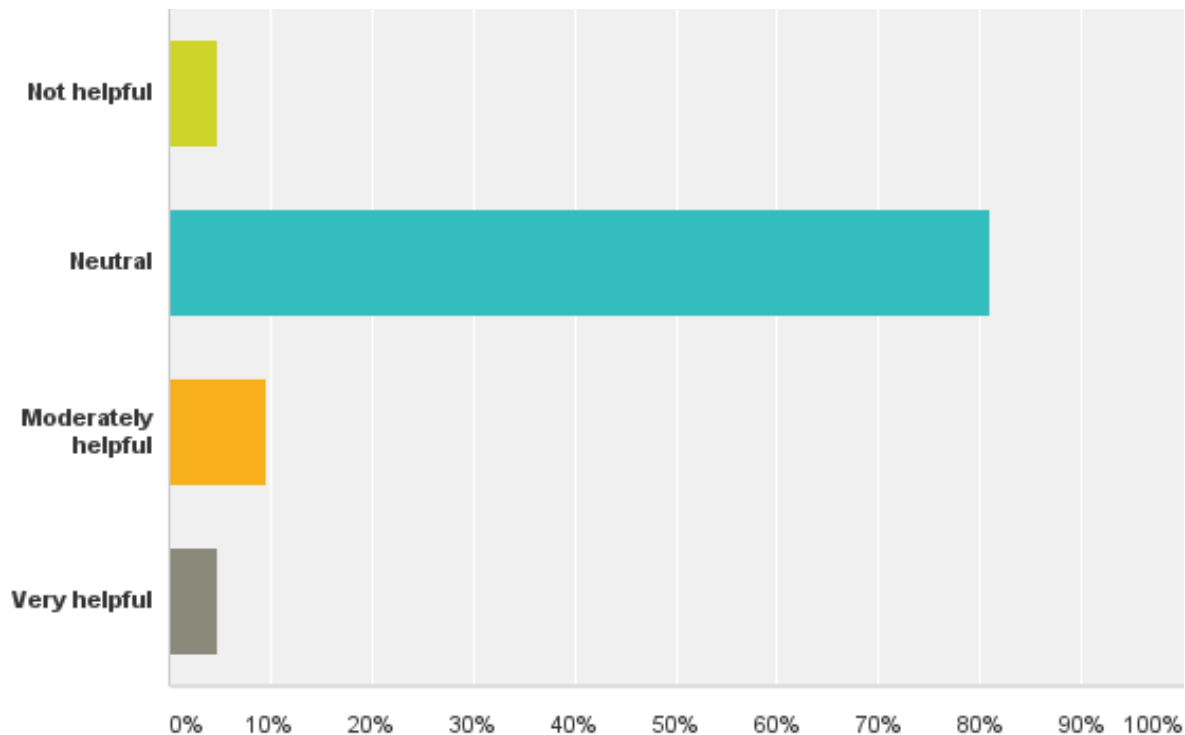
## Q4: Have you utilized the Groupspaces.com listserv for program coordinators?

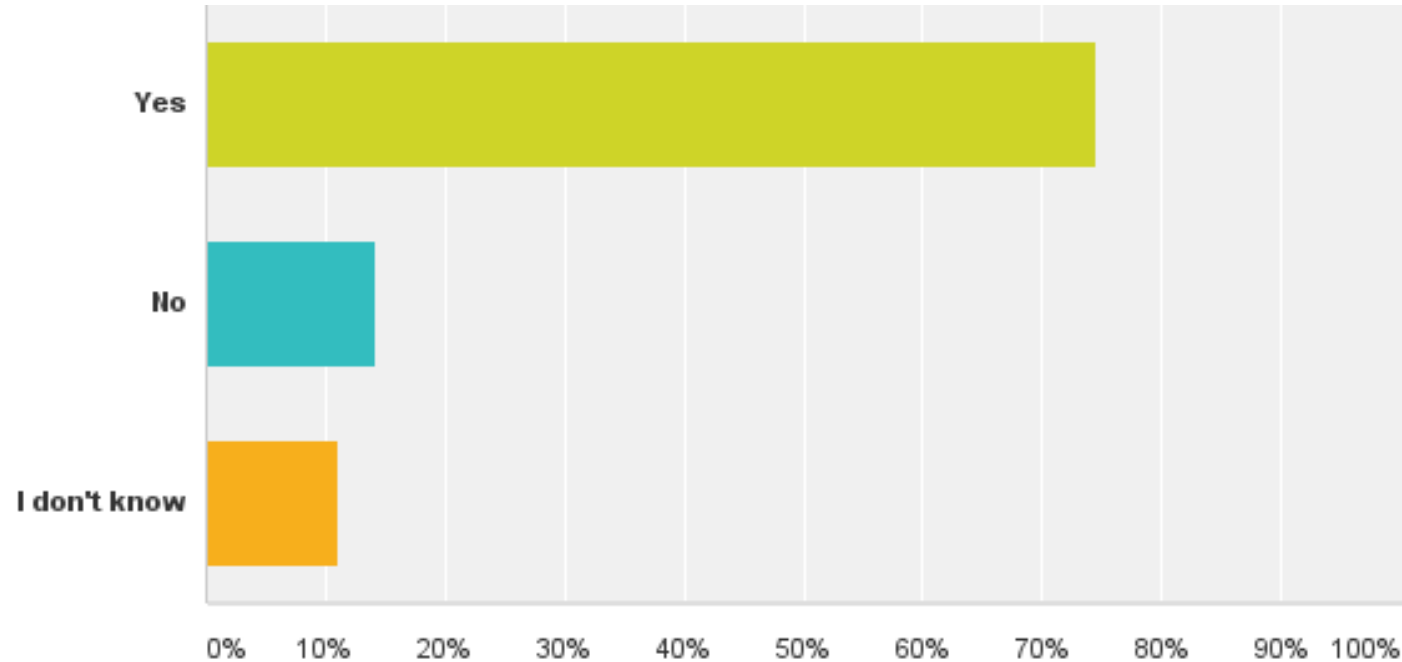
## Q5: If you have used the listserv, please give us your opinion on its usefulness?

## Q6: Does your institution provide funding for you to attend educational meetings?

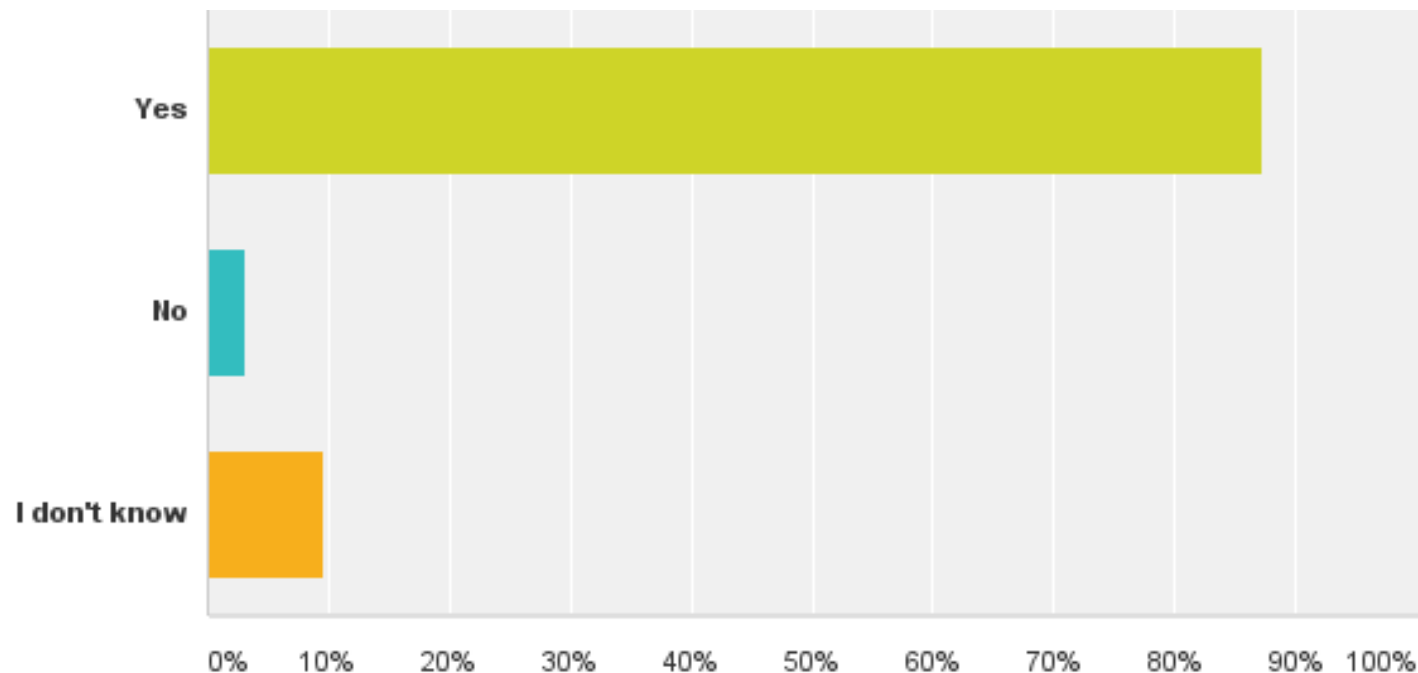

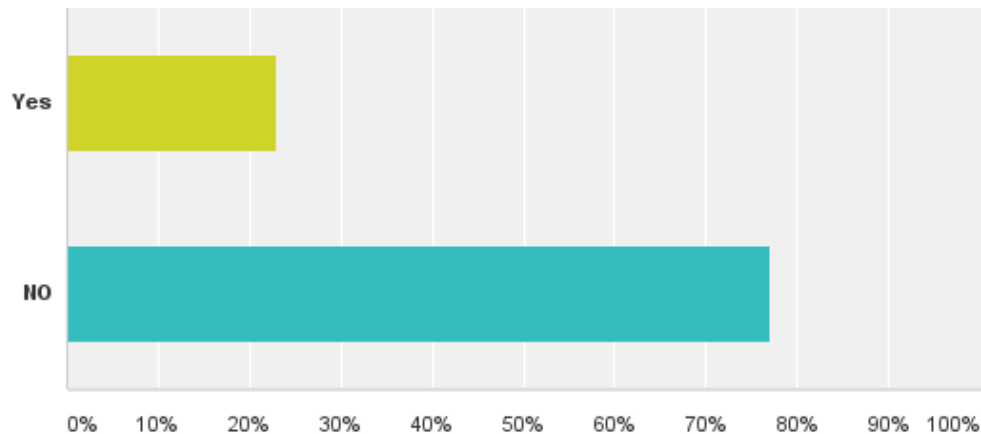
## Q7: Does your institution provide access to teleconferencing capabilities?

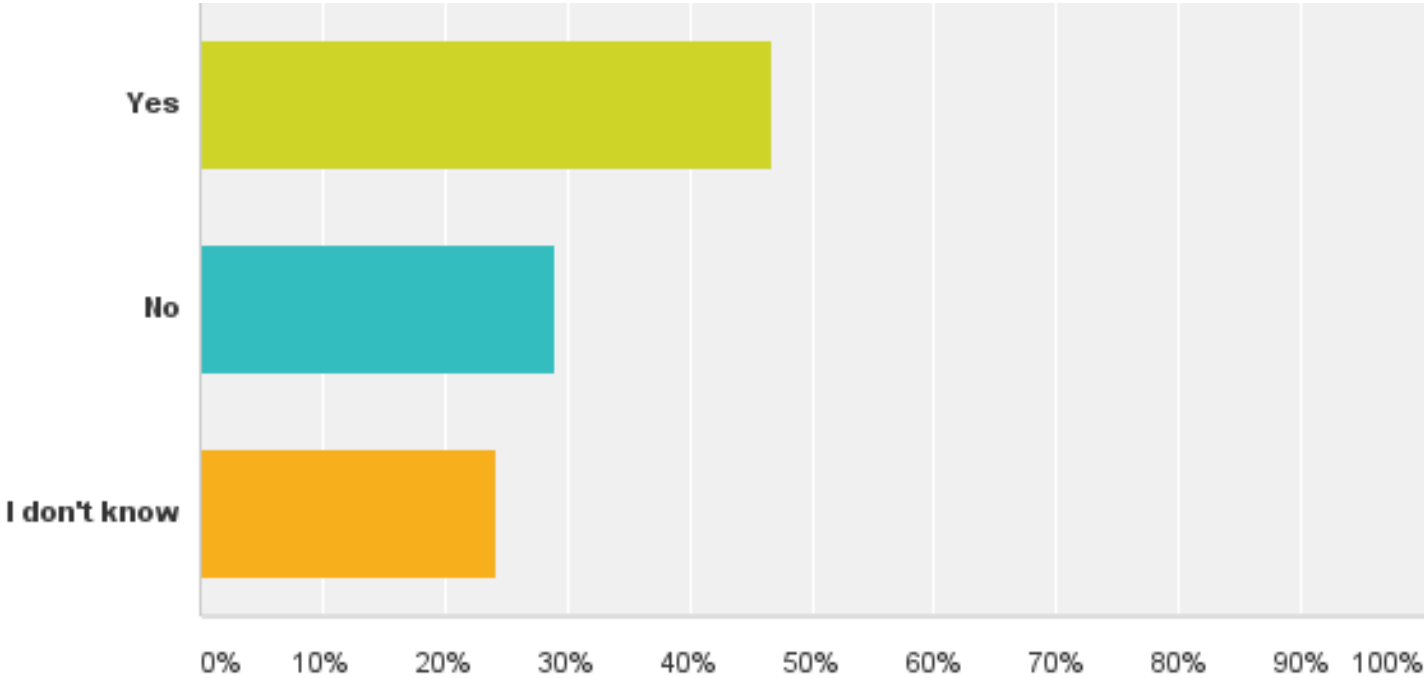
## Q8: Do you currently participate in a national coordinators forum, such as the Association of Residency Coordinators in Surgery?

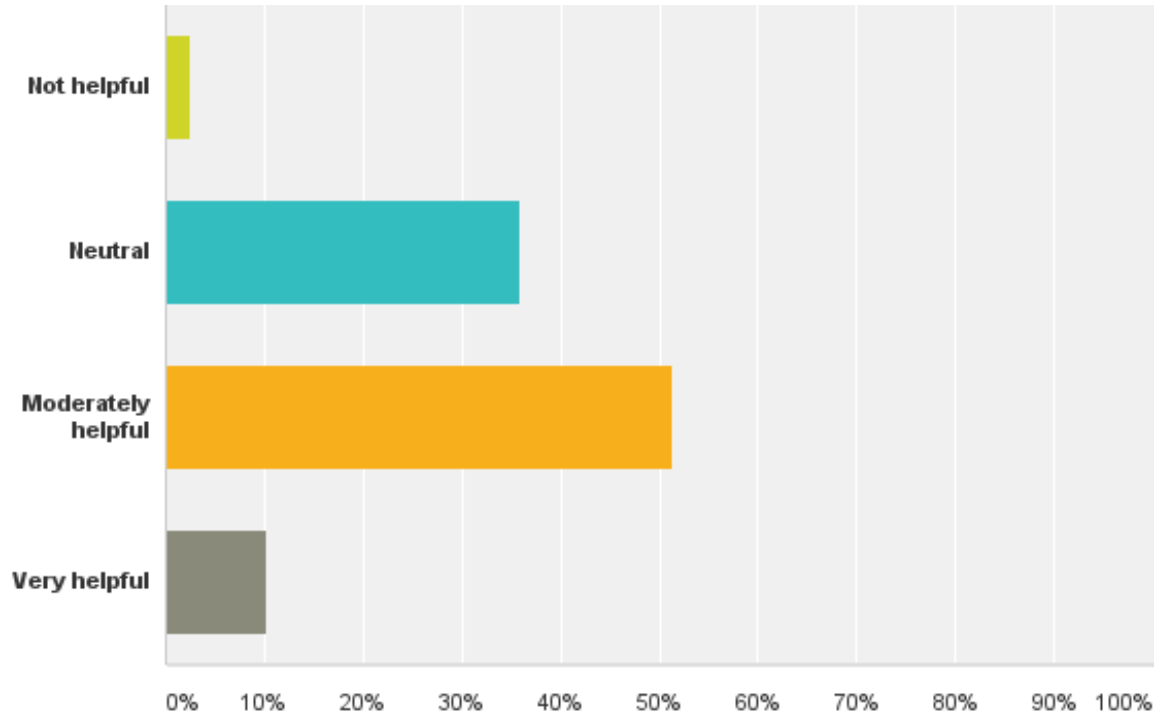
# Q9: Did you receive the newsletter from the SCCPDS this winter?
